COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Fire Hose, Streams & Appliances

This course is designed to demonstrate to firefighters the use of hoses and nozzles, adapters, and appliances and the information needed to conduct an annual service test of hose. **Friday attendance is mandatory! Full Turnout Gear is required. STUDENT MUST BE 18 years old.**
****Class starts Friday night****

Emergency Vehicle Driver

This course is designed to teach safe operation of emergency vehicles, driving skills, legal implications of emergency driving and departmental standard operating procedures. This course is a stand-alone certification and is also a prerequisite to Driver Operator Certification by the NC Fire Rescue Commission. **Friday attendance is mandatory! STUDENT MUST BE 18 years old.**
****Class starts Friday night****

Water Supply FF I & II

This course is designed to present to firefighters material that will enable him/her to demonstrate both forward and reverse hose lays from the use of a pressurized hydrant and the use of mobile supplies. This class will cover the problems and solutions faced by rural fire departments when the water supply must be transported by water tankers, the use of dry hydrants, dump tanks, and water shuttle will be covered. This class will also discuss hydrant hook up and hose lays used in the municipal setting. Practical exercises will be conducted. **Full Turnout Gear is required. STUDENT MUST BE 18 years old.**
****Class starts Friday night****

Basic Firefighting

This course is designed for the new firefighter with little or no experience. Basics to be covered include ladders, SCBA, fire streams, hose practices, etc. Practical applications will be used extensively including smoke house training. **Full turnout gear and SCBA with an extra cylinder required.**
****Class starts Friday night****

Fire Behavior FF I&II

Effective fire control requires a basic understanding of the chemical and physical nature of fire. The study of fire behavior provides the firefighter with a window into the world of fire. A window that can allow the firefighter to accurately predict what a given fire is going to do. With this understanding, the firefighter can effectively control and extinguish fires with a higher degree of safety that in turn will reduce risk to life and needless loss of property. All this enhances the firefighter's level of professionalism and dramatically increases the odds for the firefighter to remain safe while combating a fire. **Full Turnout Gear is required. STUDENT MUST BE 18 years old.**

D/O Basic Aerials

This course will study the safe actions taken to maneuver aerial devices, use telescoping booms, and articulating booms. This course shows operator candidates the safety factors that should be addressed and limitations of these types of apparatus. **Full Turnout Gear is required. STUDENT MUST BE 18 years old.**

D/O Pump Hydraulics

This course will study various states of pressure encountered in the fire service is an integral part of the Driver / Operator's knowledge. Without this understanding, all pumping operations would remain a mystery. Needless to say, setting up a pumping operation correctly would be difficult, if not impossible. **Full Turnout Gear is required. STUDENT MUST BE 18 years old.**

NC SBI Arson Detection

The class will describe the techniques and tactics used in crime scene investigation especially related to arson. Arson, the contributing factors, and warning indications to both will be defined and described in detail. In the class firefighters, company officers and incident commanders will learn the process of arson investigation in order to be able to preserve the possible crime scene for the investigators. **Full Turnout Gear is required. STUDENT MUST BE 18 years old.**
