PREREQUISITES

Basic level Programs (Basic EMT Course)

1. Must have high School Diploma, GED or documentation of a 10th grade reading level. All students will participate in a reading test prior to MR and EMT- Basic classes.
2. Must be 18 years of age.
3. Students interested in EMT that are between the age of 16 and 18 may enroll with permission from their Principle of your school, the local Board of Education and the James Sprunt Community College. An individual must be 18 yrs old to obtain certification.

ADVANCED LEVEL PROGRAMS (EMT-I)

- 1. Successful completion of all EMT- Basic certification requirements prior to participation in any clinical or field internship components of higher level courses.**
- 2. Must have high School Diploma, GED Recipient or documentation of a 12th grade reading level.**
- 3. Must be 18 years of age.**

Must achieve determined scores on the reading, writing and math sections of the Asset or Compass entrance exams at a Community College and supply those scores upon admission to class or an Associates Degree or higher with submission of official transcript.
