Veterans' Benefits

Veterans attending James Sprunt Community College may be eligible to receive benefits through the Department of Veterans' Affairs when pursuing most associate degree programs. Workforce Investment Act

Funding under this program may provide full tuition, lab fees, books, required equipment, transportation expenses, and sometimes special service allowances for eligible students depending on the availability of funds. Administration of this program varies from community to community. Students are encouraged to check with the WIA Office at the county Employment Security Commission. Applicants for this program are required to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

Hope Tax Credit, Lifetime Learning Tax Credit, and Student Loan Interest Deduction, and Tuition and Fees Deduction
