Information Relating to North Carolina Residence for Tuition Purposes

North Carolina law (G.S. 116-143.1) requires that **“To qualify as a resident for tuition purposes, a person must have established legal residence (domicile) in North Carolina and maintained that legal residence for at least 12 months immediately prior to his or her classification as a resident for tuition purposes.”** Each applicant to JSCC must supply the information requested on this form. This information is to be used only in connection with determination of your residence status for tuition purposes. **“DOMICILE”** is defined as one’s permanent dwelling place of indefinite duration, as distinguished from a temporary place of abode; synonymous with “legal residence.” A legal resident has the capacity to establish a permanent residence in the state and has lived in that permanent residence for at least the required twelve (12) months immediately preceding enrollment. Failure to provide all information requested will result in classification as a non-resident for tuition purposes.

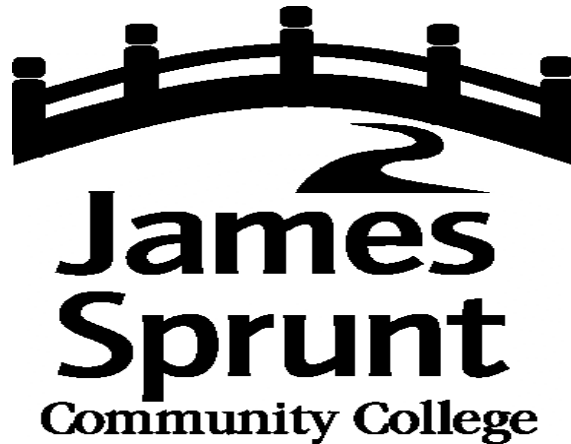

Take ASSET placement test -or- ACT -or- SAT
ASSET given 10:00 am or 6:00 pm on 1st and 2nd Mondays of each month (unless a holiday)

Nursing Applicant Procedures (In addition to above)

Check A45100 for 2 year Associate Degree Nursing (RN) (ADN) **-OR-**
D45660 for 1 year Practical Nursing Diploma (PN) (LPN)
You may only apply for the ADN or LPN program, not both.

Take NET (Nurse Entrance Test) and score sufficiently.
NET given 2nd Thursday in January, March, May, July, September, and November from 2:00-5:00 pm
Prior to day of testing - pay fee and take paid receipt to Test Administrator in Strickland Building to register for exam. Study guide can be purchased in JSCC bookstore.

Have High School level or above, with grade of 'C' or better in:
-- Biology and Chemistry for Associate Degree Nursing
-- Biology for Practical Nursing
(The Biology and Chemistry classes MUST contain a lab.)

Deadline – February 1st - Meeting all criteria by deadline allows applicant to be in selection process.
