THE STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES PROGRAM IS DESIGNED TO PROVIDE SUPPORT SERVICES TO ENHANCE STUDENTS ACADEMIC SKILLS, INCREASE THEIR RETENTION AND GRADUATION RATES AND AS APPROPRIATE, FACILITATE ENTRANCE INTO FOUR-YEAR COLLEGES.

James Sprunt Community College's Student Support Services program has a Director, Program Counselor, Special Needs Advisor, Academic Skills Advisor, Math Skills Advisor, Technology Assistant, and Administrative Assistant to provide academic, personal, financial, social, and career counseling to each participant. Counseling services will be provided to students both individually and in-group settings. The strategies used to counsel students will focus on self-concept improvement, developing of self-responsibility and problem-solving ability not only for success here, but when they transfer to another college and/or enter the world of work.

The following services are available to participants:

All participants must be currently enrolled or accepted for enrollment in the next academic term at James Sprunt and have an established need for academic assistance. All participants must be either low-income, first-generation, or have a disability.
